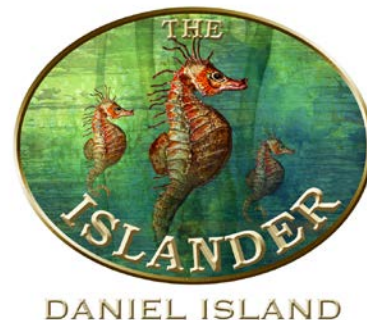

“This will be my kind of cuisine,” Whisenant explains. The Islander will provide something for everyone, including the picky eaters under 12. Whisenant has steered clear of the typical hot dogs and chicken fingers kids menu in lieu of kid friendly sushi, salads and other healthy options. Adults too will be pleased with an array of fresh local recipes.

Escape to The Islander for an “island vibe,” complete with an outdoor/indoor bar, extended patio space and complete transformation to a bright, light and airy atmosphere. The Islander will be serving dinner nightly at 5pm offering a live steel drum band and other entertainment on Friday and Saturday evenings. Lunch and brunch hours will be added to service in the coming months.
